
Subject: Jet Fuel Pipeline Replacement in CSX Right-of-Way

What is going to occur? And when?

Adjacent to the rail tracks traversing Alexandria, there is a pipeline that serves Reagan National Airport with jet fuel. Sections of the pipeline need to be relocated to allow for construction of the Fourth Track initiative: Fourth Track - VPRA (vapassengerrailauthority.org). Construction is planned to commence in July 2024.

What part of Rosemont will be impacted?

We spoke with our contact at Virginia Passenger Rail Authority, Meredith Judy, and she shared the following, "Activity related to the pipeline relocation/replacement project is unlikely to have any impact on the Rosemont neighborhood. In that section the pipeline is not currently located within the railroad right-of-way, so relocation is not necessary. CSX is progressing the design for that relocation. If there are any changes that will impact Rosemont, we will reach out to the Rosemont PELT."

Additional news

VPRA informed PELT their contractors will relocate a fiber duct bank in the fall of 2024 as part of the Fourth Track initiative. "A temporary structure will be built across/above King Street and Commonwealth Avenues (between the Metro Tracks and the CSX tracks). You may notice the structure being erected, but once it is in place it will not interrupt vehicle or pedestrian activity in the area."
